Enquiry



This terms enquiry is a History theme. Throughout our enquiry sessions this term we are going to be answering the question, **"How can we help others?"** Each week will we be building up our knowledge to answer our main question.

This term we will be looking at:

- Week 1** – We will be learning which year we are in and will be looking at the emergency services during past and present items.
 - Week 2** – We will look at important people within the community (Fire service).
 - Week 3** – We will look at important people within the community (Police service).
 - Week 4** - We will look at important people within the community (Paramedics), as well as looking at the history of Kings Mill Hospital.
 - Week 5** – We will find out how the RNLI help others.
 - Week 6** – In History, we will be finding out about Grace Darling and how she helped others.
 - Week 7** – In History, we will be finding out about Jacques Cousteau and how he helped others.
 - Week 8** – We will look plastic pollution and create sculptures in the style of Gilles Cenazandotti
 - Week 9** – We will find out about how charities help others and will design a product to sell and raise money for a charity in DT.
 - Week 10** – We will make, sell and evaluate our product in DT.
 - Week 11** – In Science, we will be identifying and investigating materials.
- We will also be visiting Sutton Library again to develop our love of books.
