<p>Research the different countries that we find in Europe. What is their flag? What is their capital city?</p> 	<p>Take photographs of/ draw geographical physical features which you think are appealing when out and about e.g. mountains, hills, rivers, seas, lakes etc.</p> 	<p>Research about natural disasters that have happened. How did it impact people's lives? Present in your own way.</p> 	<p>Draw or make a survival kit that would help you in a natural disaster. What will you need to survive?</p> 
<p>Retell the story of Pompeii in any way you choose.</p> 	<p>Create a model of one of the landmarks of Italy. This could be made of clay, playdough or cardboard.</p> 	<p>Write a poem or rap about volcanoes.</p> 	<p>Create a piece of artwork of a volcano.</p> 
<p>Create a travel guide to Italy. This could be like a paper brochure or electronic as an online guide.</p> 	<p>Use google maps to look around the capital cities of countries across Europe. You can look on street view or the flyover videos to explore. Which was your favourite and why?</p> 	<p>Write a diary entry or record a diary style video about a place that you've been to in Europe and what you enjoyed.</p> 	<p>Try an Italian recipe and cook a meal for your family.</p>
