Enquiry

This term's enquiry is a Geography theme. Throughout our enquiry sessions this term we are going to be answering the question, **"Do we always appreciate what we have?"** Each week we will be building up our knowledge to answer our main question. This term we will be looking at:

Week 1 – We will start our learning by taking a trip to Sutton Reservoir to collect data and identify human and physical features in our local community.

Week 2 – We will be exploring water safety with a visit from RNLI!

Week 3 – We will be using maps to locate and name different counties and cities in the UK.

Week 4 – In Geography, we will develop our skills in maps by identifying human and physical features in Nottinghamshire and the East Midlands.

Week 5 – We will name and locate rivers in the UK and explore how a river moves.

Week 6 – In Science, we will be exploring different habitats and how the environment can impact living things.

Week 7 – This week, we will explore the importance of a river and how the water cycle can be affected.

Week 8 – In Art, we will be looking at movement using lines, and we will start to develop a piece of art using pictures we took at Sutton Reservoir.

Week 9 – To develop our art, we will use watercolour in the style of an artist.

Week 10 – In Music, we will understand the use of pitch in music and use this to play an instrument.

Week 11 – We will develop our music skills by playing a piece of music from memory!

Week 12 – We will create our final piece of learning by creating a podcast!
