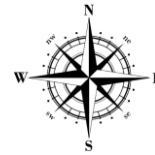
My address tells people where I live.

A compass tells us **direction** by showing North, South, East and West.



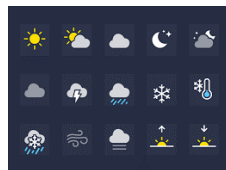
The 4 **countries** in the United Kingdom are England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.

<b>human feature</b>	Anything on the earth that has been created or changed by humans.
<b>physical feature</b>	Things that would be here if there were no people around.
<b>direction</b>	The position towards which someone or something moves or faces.
<b>country</b>	An area of land that has its own government.
<b>capital city</b>	The main city of a country where the leaders of the country work.
<b>government</b>	The people who run a country.
<b>settlement</b>	A place where people live and work.
<b>seasons</b>	The different times of the year with different types of weather.
<b>monarch</b>	A country's king or queen.
<b>architect</b>	A person who designs buildings.
<b>symbol</b>	A sign, shape or object that is used to show something else.
