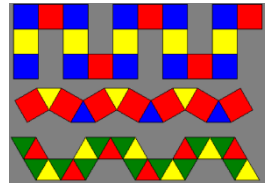


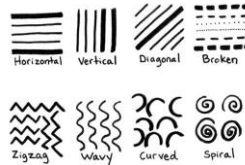
Year 1 Summer Term Knowledge Organiser

We can create lots of different types of **lines**.



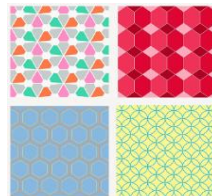
Artists can use **rubbing** to reveal the **texture** of objects.

We can create our own paths in life to be **unique**.

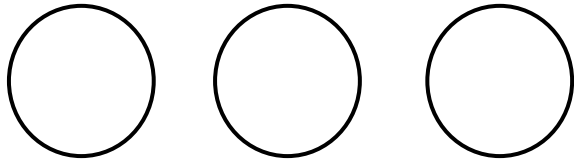


Fruit and vegetables are parts of **plants**. Lots of fruits come from hot countries.

Year 1 Summer Term Key Vocabulary

secondary colours	Secondary colours are colours we make by mixing two primary colours together. They are green, orange and purple.
repeating patterns	A repeating pattern is when shapes, colours or lines repeat again and again.
lines	Lines are marks we make in art. They can be straight, wiggly, curved, zig-zag or dotted.
rubbing	Rubbing is a way of making a picture by rubbing over paper with a crayon or pencil to show what is underneath.
texture	Texture is how something feels, like rough or smooth — or how it looks like it feels in a picture.
printing	Printing is making a picture by pressing, stamping or rolling paint.
inspired	When we are inspired, something gives us an idea for our artwork.
tribe	A tribe is a group of people who live together and share the same traditions, stories and way of life.
geometric	Geometric shapes are shapes like circles and squares that we use to make art.
unique	Unique means something is special and one of a kind. There is only one like it.
plants	They have roots, stems and leaves, and they need water, air and light to grow.
